

Spring Clean Up

As warm weather approaches we are working on building maintenance and playground updates. New mulch, more sand and some new equipment for the children to enjoy, explore around and make lasting memories with friends.

FYI

- Gentle reminder: Do NOT leave cars running while in the building, and please do NOT leave children unattended in the car.
- Gentle Reminder: A car's windows act like a greenhouse, trapping sunlight. Cars parked in direct sunlight can reach temperatures from 131 - 172 degrees Fahrenheit. In warm weather, a vehicle can warm to dangerous, life threatening levels in only 10 minutes. Just a gentle reminder children and pets should not be left unattended in your vehicle.

Helpful Tips:

- Leave your pocketbook or wallet near your child so as to go to the backseat before leaving the car.
- Explore around the baby reminder app for the iPhone or iPad.
- Explore around the precious Cargo app that works with blue tooth.
- Touch base when arriving to work with a family member, friend or co-worker as a check system.
- Don't be embarrassed, be aware
